Going Deeper: The hand behind the thigh

<u>"Put I pray thy hand under my thigh".</u> That this signifies pledging it according to its power to the good of shared love, is evident from the signification of "hand," as being power; and from the signification of "thigh," as being the good of committed love, concerning which in what follows.

These things were well known to the men of the most ancient times; and therefore they had a number of rites based on this correspondence, of which one was that they placed the hands under the thigh when they were pledged to any good of commitment in love.
